More KL notes - (1) Two opinions for 7D people: Either strict full 7 days after the molad, or as long as it's within a few hours, they say KL. Both are legit. (2) KL on Leil Shabbat and Leil Yom Tov only if it's the last opportunity.

Tishrei's KL: Most wait until Motza'ei YK • [GRA] MON Sep 18 • [7D] Motza"sh Sep 23 • [last] Fri Sep 30 - until 12:40am

▼ Before YK candles, the custom is to light memorial candles and one additional 24-hr candle "for the living". This candle should be used to light the havdala candle, rather than the usual "creation" of new fire for havdala. This is known as NER SHESHAVAT, a flame that rested throughout YK. ▼
